Adelphi University's Door Accessibility Problem Solved by Power Access

Needing to comply with ADA in 1992, Craig Kennedy, associate physical plant director at Garden City, New York's Adelphi University, began to review their buildings in order to make them accessible. Installing ADA compliant door openers was one of the areas that needed to be addressed.

After reviewing several different door openers they selected one and installed it in two buildings as a tryout. Shortly after installation, Craig realized that this particular model was *not going to work* because it forced the door to open automatically and did not allow the door to be used manually, ever! This meant that the door opener was in continual use that did not suit Craig's needs.

Still needing to resolve the door opener situation, Craig decided to install Power Access units in a couple of buildings. He went with Power Access because he liked the fact that the door opener's wheeled arm did not attach to the door and therefore, the door could be used as both a manual and an automatic door. The door openers were supplied by Northport, New York based **Barrier Free Access Systems, Inc.**

A few weeks after installation, the Power Access door openers got good reviews, were well received and remained trouble-free, so Adelphi made them their door opener of choice.

The Power Access door opener is low-cost, virtually maintenance free and has important built-in safety features-both mechanical and electrical. The operator arm is not attached to the door. Instead, a wheel at the end of the operator arm rolls against the face of the door, pushing the door open. The importance of this unique feature is that the door can always be opened manually from either side without involving the operator. The operator does not hinder traffic flow through the doorway. The Power Access door opener

is always used in conjunction with a conventional door closer, either surface-mounted or concealed. If the door meets an obstruction during the opening cycle, a built-in load sensing circuit automatically stops the operator and the arm returns to the atrest₃ or closed position.

The drive motor is thermally protected. Door hold-open time can be set for as long as 30 seconds, longer if necessary. A range of door sizes and opening forces can be accommodated. The unit easily retrofits onto most existing doorways with no modification to the door or frame required.

The Power Access door opener is simple to install. No modification of the door or jambs is required and it just plugs into a regular 115 V wall outlet. Complete instructions are packed with every unit. Perfect for educational and health care facilities that are trying to comply with ADA, the Power Access door opener is designed for versatility. It fits most interior and some exterior door applications. Left and right hand units are available. Jamb mount or door mount. If there is not room enough room above the door, there is an inverted model.

The Power Access door opener is activated by an electric signal. For your convenience, we have developed an array of controls adapted for special needs. Choose from push button or push plate wall styles, wireless coded radio-controlled switches.

Adelphi University has been using Power Access door openers for over seven years and will continue to install them as needed. "The door openers perform very well, are trouble-free and withstand a lot of abuse," Craig explains, "however, when a unit is damaged Power Access usually responds within a day so their customer service is excellent."
